



**Professor James Buchan** is Senior Fellow at the Health Foundation. He is also Adjunct Professor the WHO Collaborating Centre for Nursing, University of Technology, Sydney (UTS), Australia; and a Visiting Professor at the School of Nursing, University of Edinburgh, Scotland.

He has specialized in nursing workforce policy throughout his career. His background includes periods working at a senior level in government in Scotland and Australia; and as senior policy adviser for the Royal College of Nursing, (RCN), UK. He has also worked for WHO in Geneva and Copenhagen. In recent years he has had extensive experience as a consultant on nursing workforce policy and planning, in Europe, the Americas, the Gulf, Asia and the Pacific, for governments and international agencies. He is Editor in Chief of “Human Resources for Health”, the peer reviewed journal affiliated with WHO.
